

Let's Look At Who Sophia Is

The following is taken from "The Secret Teachings of Jesus", of which, within it are four Books: 1. The Secret Book of James; 2. The Gospel of Thomas; 3. The Book of Thomas; 4. "Yet we would not know...., we would not understand what is immeasurable, were it not for one who has come from the Father and has told us these things.

For the Perfect One beholds itself in the light surrounding it. This is the spring of the water of life that gives forth all the worlds of every kind. The Perfect One gazes upon its image, sees it in the spring of the spirit and falls in love with the luminous water. This is the spring of pure, luminous water surrounding the Perfect One.

"It's Thought became active, and she who appeared in the presence of the Father in shining light came forth. She is the first power: she preceded everything, and came forth from the Father's mind as the Forethought of all. Her light resembles the Father's light; as the perfect power, she is the image of the perfect and invisible virgin Spirit. She is:

the first power,

the glory,

Barbelo,

the perfect glory among the worlds,

the emerging glory.

She glorified and praised the Virgin Spirit, for she had come forth through the Spirit. She is the first Thought, the image of the Spirit. She became the universal womb, for she precedes everything,

the triple male,
the triple power,
the androgynous one with three names,
the eternal realm among the invisible beings,
the first to come forth.

Let's Look At What Sophia Did

"Now Sophia, who is the Wisdom of Afterthought and who represents an eternal realm, conceived of a thought. She had this idea herself, and the invisible Spirit and Foreknowledge also reflected upon it. She wanted to give birth to a being like herself without permission of the Spirit (the Spirit had not given approval), without her lover, and without his consideration.

Her partner did not give his approval she did not find anyone who agreed with her; and she considered this matter without the Spirit's permission or any knowledge of what she had decided. Nonetheless, she brought forth a child. And because of the unconquerable power within her, her thought was not an idle though. Rather, something came out of her that was imperfect and different in appearance from her, for she had produced it without her lover. It did not look like its Mother, and had a different shape.

"When Sophia saw what her **desire had produced**, it changed into the figure of a snake with the face of a lion. Its eyes were like flashing bolts of lightning. She threw it away from her, outside that realm, so that none of the Immortals would see it. For she had produced it ignorantly.

She surrounded it with a bright cloud, and put a throne in the middle of the cloud, so that no one would see it except the holy Spirit, who is called the Mother of the Living. She named her child Yaldabaoth.

"Yaldabaoth is the first ruler, who took great power from his Mother. Then he left her and moved away from the realms where he was born. He was strong and created for himself other realms by means of a bright flame of fire that still exists. He mated with the Mindlessness that is in him, and produced his own authorities:

The name of the first is Athoth, whom generations of human beings call....

The second is Harmas, who is the jealous eye.

The third is Kalila-Oumbri.

The fourth is Yable.

The fifth is Adonaios, who is called Sabatoth.

The sixth is Cain, whom generations of human beings call the sun.

The seventh is Abel.

The eighth is Abrisene.

The ninth is Yobel

The tenth is Armoupiael.

The eleventh is Melcheir-Adonein.

The Twelfth is Belias, who is over the depths of the underworld.

"Yaldabaoth stationed seven kings (one for each sphere of heaven) to reign over the seven heavens and five to reign over the depths of hell. He shared his fire with them, but did not give away any of the power of the light that he had taken from his Mother. For he is a being of ignorant darkness.

"When the light mixed with the darkness, it made the darkness brighter. When the darkness mixed with the light, it dimmed the light. The result was neither light nor darkness, but rather gloom.

"This gloomy ruler has three names:

The first name Yaldabaoth.

The second is Sklas.

The third is Samael.

He is wicked because of the Mindlessness that is in him. For he said to them,

"I am God, and there is no other God besides me."

Since he did not know from where his own strength had come.

"The rulers created for themselves seven powers. The powers in turn created for themselves six angels apiece, until there were three hundred sixty-five angles. These are the names of the potentates and their corresponding physiques:

The first is Athoth, and has the face of a sheep.

The second is Eloaios, and has the face of a donkey.

The third Astaphaios, and has the face of a hyena.

The fourth is Yao, and has the face of a snake with seven heads.

The fifth is Sabaoth, and has the face of a dragon.

The sixth is Adonin, and has the face of an ape.

The seventh is Sabbataios, and has a face of flaming fire.

This explains the seven days of the week.

"Yaldabaoth had many faces in addition to all of these, so that he could show whatever face he wanted when he was among the angels. He shared his fire with the, and lorded it over them because of the glorious power had form his Mother's light. That is why he called himself God, and disregarded the realm for which he came.

"He united seven of his powers of thought with the authorities that were with him. When he spoke, it was done. He named each of his powers beginning with the highest:

The first power is Goodness, and is with the first authority, Athoth.

The second power is Forethought, and is with the second authority, Eloaios.

The third power is Divinity, and is with the third authority, Astaphaios.

The fourth power is Lordship, and is with the fourth authority, Yao.

The fifth power is Kingdom, and is with the fifth authority, Sabaoth.

The sixth power is Jealousy, and is with the sixth authority, Adonin.

The seventh power is Understanding, and is with the seventh authority, Sabbataios.

These beings have spheres in the heavenly realms.

"The powers were given names from the glory above, but these names could destroy the powers. For a while the names given them by their creator were powerful, the names given them from the glory above could bring about their destruction and loss of power. That is why they have two names.

"Yaldabaoth organized everything after the pattern of the first eternal realms that had come into being, for he wished to create beings that are like the Imperishable Ones. Not that he had seen the Imperishable Ones. Rather, the power that is in him, that he had taken from his Mother, produced the pattern for the world order.

"When he saw creation all around, and the throng of angels around him that had come forth from him, he said to them,

'I am a jealous God, and there is no other God besides me."

But by making this announcement, he suggested to the angels with him that there is another God. For if there were no other God, of whom would he be jealous?

"Then the Mother began to move around. She realized that she was lacking something when the brightness of her light diminished. She grew dim because her lover had not collaborated with her."

I said, "Lord, what does it mean that she moved around?"

The Lord laughed and said, "Do not suppose that it happened the way Moses said, 'above the waters." No, when she recognized the wickedness that had taken place, and the robbery her son had committed, she repented. Though she had be-

"When the Mother realized that this dark shadow had come into being imperfectly, she understood that her lover had not collaborated with her. She repented with many tears. The whole realm of Fullness of the invisible virgin Spirit heard her prayer of repentance and offered praise for her, and the holy Spirit poured some of this Fullness upon her. For her lover had not come to her before, but now he did come to her, down through the realm of Fullness, so that he might restore what she lacked.
